

Cinnamon Cove's Reusable Transponders for CC Unit Owners With Leased Vehicles

In order to accommodate Unit Owners who fly to Florida and lease/rent vehicles for their local transportation while residing in CC, the Master Association Board's modified procedure for leased vehicles is as follows: To provide a personalized (owner specific) transponder on a clear plastic plaque that will be displayed in the designated location on the dashboard of the Unit Owner's leased vehicle.

This reusable transponder will ONLY be activated after the required Driver's License/ID verification and registration process for the leased vehicle has been completed. Upon departure from CC, the Unit Owner will return his/her personalized transponder to the Access Control Officer at the front gate for deactivation until the Unit Owner returns to CC and completes a re-activation registration process for a different leased vehicle. The step by step procedure is as follows:

1. Upon arrival, the unit owner shall present his/her driver's license (or ID) to the Access Control Officer on duty at the Front Entrance Welcome Center on Cinnamon Cove Blvd. A temporary access pass will be issued to the unit owner.
2. The unit owner shall register his/her currently leased vehicle with the CC Recreation Office in the clubhouse in a timely manner. To help expedite the process of obtaining a reusable transponder, the unit owner may (but is not required to) pre-register his/her leased vehicle data online at <https://community.dwellinglive.com> prior to coming to the Recreation Office to complete the registration process.

Dwelling Live will be updated and Transponders issued at the Recreation Office, from 3:00 PM to 3:30 PM, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, during October through April, and on Monday and Tuesday from 3:00 PM to 3:30PM during May through September.

- The unit owner will provide his/her expected departure date.
- An activated transponder affixed to a clear plastic plaque will be issued to the unit owner with the unit owner's identity clearly displayed on the plaque.
- The transponder will be deactivated on the registered departure date.
- Upon unit owner's departure, he/she shall return the transponder (affixed to the clear plastic plaque) to the Access Control Officer. It will be placed in an envelope with the unit owner's name on it.

Subsequent Visits to CC

- Upon return for another stay in CC, the unit owner shall update his/her registration with the Recreation Office and retrieve the personalized reusable transponder from the Access Control Officer. The transponder will be reactivated for the unit owner's use during the period of his/her stay at CC and will be returned to the Access Control Officer at the end of each stay.
